We are in a significant season as a church.

We have heard God's call, confirmed His vision, committed to step into His direction, and collected generous first commitments toward Mission: Impact. As we take steps toward this expansion, we cannot forget our roots. We must strengthen our stakes.

In Isaiah 54, God prepares His people for expansion. But before they expand, He tells them to strengthen their stakes. Before they stretch their tent outward, they must anchor themselves deeper. Before growth becomes visible, foundations must become secure. Expansion requires reinforcement. Growth requires stability.

We spent last year strengthening the stakes. Our stakes are all that goes into making disciples who live and love like Jesus. We serve, give, worship, pray, and grow toward that end. As we grow, we will not forget our roots. We will not build without a strong foundation. Last year, we drove our stakes down even deeper to support the expansion God is calling us toward. 

COMMITMENT TO INTEGRITY

NCC has been a member of the ECFA (Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability) since 2000.

We also participate in a voluntary annual audit/review by an accredited CPA firm. The financials and controls are then submitted to the Elder Board for their review.

ACTS FUND

The ACTS Fund is a special benevolence fund created to care for individuals and families within NCC and those closely connected to our church who are experiencing short-term financial hardship.

This year, the ACTS Fund provided **\$29,577** in targeted financial assistance to 15 individuals and families, covering essential expenses such as rent or mortgage, utilities, and groceries.

ELDER BOARD

Throughout 2025, our Elders faithfully shepherded NCC through a season of growth, discernment, and preparation. They deepened their focus on prayer and disciple-making, strengthened governance through updated bylaws and an Elder Manual refresh, and helped lead the vision and stewardship of the Mission: Impact campaign.

Their leadership helped foster greater unity, increased engagement, and a continued emphasis on being a church that lives out its mission beyond Sunday mornings.

MISSION: IMPACT RECAP

OVERVIEW

Mission: Impact is both a building expansion and a mission expansion initiative that began in October 2025. Through this campaign, our church is investing in facilities that better support worship, discipleship, students, and prayer, while also committing to increased generosity beyond our walls.

By giving 10% of campaign funds directly to missions, Mission: Impact reflects our conviction that expanding our footprint must always be matched by expanding our faithfulness to God's mission in the world.

ENGAGEMENT & GIVING

Mission: Impact emphasized 100% engagement, calling every person to participate through prayer, worship, Scripture, community, and generosity.

The campaign encouraged each individual to take a personal next step along a path of growing generosity. We believe that faithful participation—at every level—honors God and strengthens the church.

SERMON SERIES RECAP

WEEK 1 God, We, and Me | Matthew 16:13-20; John 1:35-42

Jesus builds the Church one person at a time through personal invitation and relationship. He calls individuals by name and invited them to follow Him. God is still at work, using each of us to build His Church and advance His Kingdom. God builds WE through ME.

WEEK 2 Jesus' Kind of Church | Matthew 28:16-20; 1 Peter 2:1-10

Jesus' vision for the Church stood apart from ways of building a church. Some hid like submarines, some fought like battleships, and some wanted every comfort like a cruise ship. Instead of isolation, force, or comfort-based faith, Jesus established a Church like an aircraft carrier. People land, get fed, healed, trained, and then sent back out to make an impact for His Kingdom. We will build an aircraft carrier kind of church.

WEEK 3 Generosity and Discipleship | Matthew 6:19-21; 2 Corinthians 9:6-15; 1 Corinthians 16:1-2

Jesus considered how we manage our finances as a central aspect of our discipleship. We learned how money can shape our hearts, either drawing us away from God or becoming a tool in His hands. Jesus taught that generosity honors God, blesses us, and sparks faith and praise in others.

WEEK 4 It's Easier to Stay Here Than Go There | Exodus 14:10-14; Joshua 3:9-17

There is a biblical pattern of God calling people from HERE to THERE. It takes faith to move THERE, breaking through the tendency to get stuck HERE or worse, go back to where we WERE. God continually leads His people forward, even when fear or resistance tempt us to stay put or turn back.

WEEK 5 Who am I? Who are We? | 1 Chronicles 29:1-20; 2 Corinthians 8:2-9

We reflected on God's longstanding call for His people to live generously by first offering themselves fully to Him. In this special service, we followed in the footsteps of generations who have faithfully and sacrificially given to God's work in the spirit of the words of David: "But who am I, and who are my people, that we should be able to give as generously as this? Everything comes from you, and we have given you only what comes from your hand" (1 Chronicles 29:14).






STRENGTHEN THE STAKES


